How to help the victims during Hurricane Harvey and Irma?

During this difficult time, a lot of families lost their homes, cars, and all their belongings. Some became homeless and they lacked of food or drinking water. Others were very stressed, and worried about how to start again.

Resources for families are needed during and after disaster. How can we help? If you have families or friends living in these effected areas, please try to contact them and offer them some help and be compassionate about what are they going through.

- ⇒ Make a Donation through reputable organizations.
- ⇒ Volunteer if you have the skills and knowledge.

How can you be prepared for disaster?

Start preparing for an emergency or disaster before anything happens. You should find reliable information sources, warning systems and alert systems in advance. Family communication is very important. Meet with family members and consider both people and pets.

Because your family may not be together when a disaster strikes it is important to create a plan in advance. It is also essential to have a disaster supplies kit that includes basic items from your home that you may need in case of emergency. Your plan should include:

- # How you will get to a safe place
- # How you will contact each other
- # How you will get back together
- # What you will do in different situations
